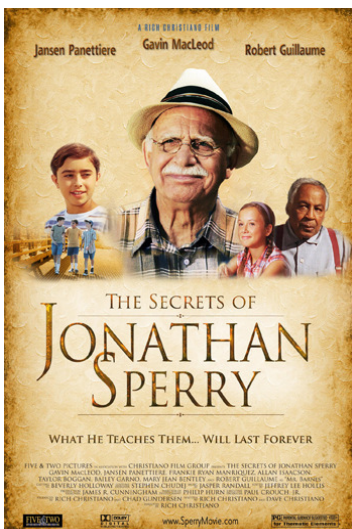

## August—A Time for Getting Ready

As schools prepare for a new school year, our church prepares for a new church year which begins September 1. There are three major areas that we focus our attention in the month of August.

1. Election of Deacons – Active deacons rotate off their active status after three years and are ineligible to return to active status for one year. They are replaced by new deacons duly nominated and elected by the church. You will be asked to nominate new men on the second Sunday in August and then elect two men from four nominees on the third Sunday in August. The newly elected deacons will assume their office on September 1 for three years.
2. Nomination and Election of all other Leaders, Teachers, and Committee Members in the Church – Our present Nominating Committee diligently searches out and then nominates men and women to all the positions in the ministry or work of the church. They have sought and continue to seek input from us in order to place members in areas that their gifts enable them to serve gladly and effectively for the glory of God. On the last Wednesday in August, the Nominating Committee submits their report of nominees to the church in the annual business meeting for church approval.
3. The Ministry Budget of the Church – The Finance Committee is responsible for preparing a church budget which is presented to the church for approval in the Annual Meeting on Wednesday, August 26 at 7 P.M. A ministry budget helps us to wisely use the tithes and offerings of God's people for Kingdom purposes.

What we do in August matters much. Pray that we choose and act wisely.
