REVIVAL SERVICES BEGIN SUNDAY, MARCH 15

Why do we plan a series of meetings called revival services? Here are some reasons:

- Some do not know where they stand with God. They are not sure whether they are saved or lost, heaven-bound or hell-bound. The Bible says, "Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith." A revival gives good opportunity to do so.
- Some have drifted from their walk with Christ. Any kind of drifting eventually brings us into harm's way. A revival usually helps us to detect and correct our course.
- Some become frustrated and weary in well-doing. Jesus said, "Come unto me and I will give you rest." That divine dispensation of rest renews and revives our body, mind and spirit.
- Some find themselves ensnared in sinful addictions. Jesus said, "If you continue in my word... you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free." Sitting before the preaching of God's truth is liberating, and especially when the truth keeps impacting us in a series of meetings.
- Some are trapped in the evil trinity of worry, fear and anxiety. Only healthy faith in a loving and all-powerful God can overcome these emotional tyrants. The Bible says that faith comes by hearing the Word of God.
- Some have just fallen out of love with Jesus and no longer worship, live and serve in gladness of heart. The Bible says that faith, hope and love remain, but the greatest of these is love. A revival is a great opportunity to have our love restored by God and for God.

On Palm Sunday evening, April 5, we hope to present an Easter drama entitled, *The Upper Room*.
